

Erasmus+ Capacity Building of Higher Education (CBHE) “Multidisciplinary Skills for Artists’ Entrepreneurship (MUSAE) project

Turin Polytechnic University in Tashkent, State Conservatory of Uzbekistan and National Institute of Fine Arts and Design named after Kamoliddin Behzod jointly launched “Entrepreneurship skills in Art, Music and Creativity” course on the basis of the Erasmus+ Capacity Building of Higher Education (CBHE) “Multidisciplinary Skills for Artists’ Entrepreneurship (MUSAE) project”.
